SUBJECT: SMOM 18-059, Announcement of the ARNG 79T Senior Leader Course (SLC) Surge

1. References:

2. Purpose. The Strength Maintenance Training Center will conduct a SLC Surge during the First Quarter of FY19. The SLC Class 19-002, 26 November - 14 December, will increase the total class size to 160 Soldiers. This will provide training for an additional 128 Soldiers and help reduce the nationwide SLC backlog.

3. Priority of fill for the additional course seats will be:

- a. Current SFCs who have not completed the SLC.
- b. SSGs who have been selected for promotion and have not completed the SLC.
- c. SSGs who have not been selected for promotion and have not completed the SLC.

4. Allocation of training seats for each state and territory will be managed by ARNG-HRR.
