### MEMORANDUM FOR NG J1 RRF (All-Entire RRF)

SUBJECT: SMOM 18-070, Reclassification Requirements for 79T Recruiting and Retention NCO

1. Reference.

- a. NGR 601-1, Army National Guard Strength Maintenance Program, 26 April 2006.

- c. NGR 600-200, Enlisted Personnel Management, 31 July 2009.

2. Purpose. Establish requirements for reclassification to 79T MOS.

3. Reclassification. Soldiers must meet the following criteria:

- a. Be a Title 32 AGR FTNGD production Recruiting and Retention Noncommissioned Officer (RRNCO) in the ranks of SGT thru SFC, currently serving in a valid 79T position.
- b. Have graduated from the ARNG Non-Career Recruiter Course (805B-SQI4).
- c. Be a graduate of Advanced Leader Course (ALC). No waiver authorized.
- d. Demonstrate at least 18 successful months as a T-32 production RRNCO (Three Tenet Mission). No waiver authorized.
- e. Be awarded the Senior Recruiting and Retention badge since completion of the ARNG Non-Career Recruiter Course. No waiver authorized.
- f. Meet all requirements of DA PAM 611-21 for MOS 79T. Exception to Policy's (ETP) will be considered on a case by case basis. Submit ETPs to the 79T Proponent NCO (see enclosure 3).

4. Process. Soldiers must request conversion to 79T MOS thru their command channels. Recruiting and Retention Battalions will forward the DA 4187 to the 79T Proponent NCO for verification and validation. The 79T Proponent NCO will either return or forward the DA 4187 for approval to the Chief, HRR. Incomplete reclassification packets will be returned to the state. Approved/ Disapproved reclassification packets will be returned to

the state by the 79T Proponent NCO.

5. Effective 1 January 2018, the 79T Conversion Course is no longer required for conversion to 79T MOS.

6. This message remains valid until 30 September 2019, or rescinded by this office.
