SUBJECT: SMOM 19-010, NPS Split Training Option (STO) Eligible MOSs and Renegotiation into OSUT MOSs

2. This SMOM rescinds SMOM 16-001.

3. The listed MOSs are authorized for STO applicants who are within 270 days of the RECSTA date. MOS 12B, 12C, and 31B must adhere to the guidance listed in the AOC, para 5-60c(3).

4. Renegotiation. Soldiers who require renegotiation action must choose a MOS that will fulfill the critical need of the State. Renegotiation into an OSUT MOS will only be completed using the standard training path, even when the Soldier does not require BCT. Renegotiations are completed as outlined in reference 1b.
